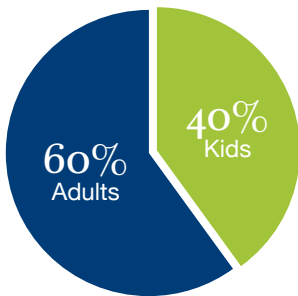

Ohio Medicaid Population:



60,000 kids require complex care

35,000 kids in foster care or adopted

42,000 kids with significant behavioral health needs



In Ohio, the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) is a part of Ohio Medicaid.

242,000 kids are eligible for Medicaid through CHIP.

CHIP is the federal program for uninsured children.



For every \$1 Ohio spends on Medicaid, we receive \$2 in federal match.



MEDICAID COVERS MORE THAN 50% OF ALL OHIO BIRTHS.



MEDICAID REIMBURSEMENTS DO NOT COVER THE COST OF CARE

Medicaid reimburses just

76¢ for every \$1 of care provided.
